



Job Title: Senior Manager, International Taxation

What is the opportunity?

As a Senior Manager, International Taxation, you will directly assist the Senior levels of the RBC Taxation Group (i.e., the Director, International Taxation, Senior Directors, International Taxation, VP, International Taxation, and at times the other VPs in the RBC Taxation Group) with identifying and implementing international tax planning initiatives and providing specialized international tax advisory services, with an emphasis on the Canadian taxation of RBC's international subsidiaries, to all of RBC's Business Units. In addition, you will directly be responsible and accountable for ensuring that RBC's Canadian tax reporting and tax compliance obligations as they relate to RBC and its international subsidiaries are completed in a timely manner. These two primary responsibilities are an integral component of RBC's tax function, being to enhance shareholder value by minimizing tax risk and tax costs across the organization while ensuring compliance with tax laws.

What will you do?

International Tax Advisory

- Works closely with and supports the Director, International Taxation and the Senior Directors, International Taxation in identifying, researching and resolving international income tax issues (i.e., Canadian FAPI issues, surplus issues, local tax matters, withholding taxes, tax treaties).
- Works closely with the Director, International Taxation and the Senior Directors, International Taxation with the implementation of plans, strategies and projects in the international tax area.
- Assists with the review of transactions for BU and FU strategies, proposals and PARS, to mitigate overall RBC tax liability, within delegated authority under the supervision of the Director, International Taxation and the Senior Directors, International Taxation.
- Supports the Director, International Taxation and the Senior Directors, International Taxation in proactively reviewing and managing current international tax strategies.
- Possesses awareness of tax transfer pricing rules in Canada and internationally.
- Keeps abreast of developments of Canadian tax legislation affecting RBC's international operations to determine and communicate impact to RBC.

International Tax Compliance

- Support Director, International Taxation and Senior Directors, International Taxation in representing RBC in meetings with Tax Authorities, Professional Organizations and Industry Associations.
- Research and prepare responses to CRA audit queries related to foreign affiliates.

- Collaborate with the other Senior Manager, International Taxation to prepare and file related party and foreign reporting information returns for foreign affiliates (Forms T106 and T1134) as required by Canadian tax laws with respect to international subsidiaries.
- Collaborate with the other Senior Manager, International Taxation in preparing the surplus computations for foreign affiliates of RBC and its Canadian subsidiaries and in meeting RBC's Country-by-Country reporting requirements.
- Monitor changes to the Canadian foreign compliance requirements of RBC and inform the Directors, International Taxation and Senior Directors, International Taxation of changes.
- Prepare the calculation of FAPI for RBC and its Canadian subsidiaries on an annual basis.
- Keep abreast of international tax legislative developments to determine and communicate impact and recommended strategies and solutions to VP, International Taxation and as required to RBC Executives and RBC BUs

What do you need to succeed?

Must Have

- Chartered Professional Accountant, Lawyer or equivalent having completed the CPA In-Depth Tax Program or equivalent.
- Minimum 4 years of full time tax experience in a large corporation, major accounting firm or law firm with a focus on rules specifically related to the Canadian taxation of international subsidiaries.
- Strong knowledge of Canadian federal income tax laws, foreign affiliate taxation rules, international tax treaties as well as basic knowledge of transfer pricing.
- Strong knowledge of accounting principles.
- Strong computer skills, including detailed knowledge of Excel and tax preparation software, as well as PowerPoint.
- Above average skills in communication (both in oral and written form) of complex technical tax implications of transactions to support the Director, International Taxation and the Senior Directors, International Taxation in their dealings with senior BU and FU representatives and peers.
- Detail oriented, ability to meet deadlines and able to work under pressure.
