



Notice to the Public and the Profession

Cancellation of Sitings

Due to the increased prevalence of COVID-19 in cities where the Tax Court of Canada currently holds proceedings, and the associated impact of travel on the health and safety of all involved in these proceedings, the Chief Justice has cancelled all in-person Court sittings scheduled between November 30th, 2020 and January 15, 2021, inclusively.

Please note that select appeals underway this week in Montreal and scheduled to conclude on November 30th and December 1st, 2020, will proceed. The parties involved in these appeals have already been advised accordingly.

Conference calls are not affected by this cancellation and will proceed as scheduled.

Parties affected by these cancellations will be contacted directly by the Registry staff in the coming days.

The Chief Justice will continue to monitor the situation closely and will reassess the week of January 4, 2021, whether the judicial sittings schedule will have to be further altered.

The Court and its Registry offices remain open, with the exception of the Hamilton office.
