Matias Milet is the 2008 recipient of the Canadian Tax Foundation's Douglas J. Sherbaniuk Distinguished Writing Award. His article, "Permanent Establishments Through Related Corporations Under the OECD Model Treaty," was published in (2007) vol. 55, no. 2 *Canadian Tax Journal* 289-330. The article was selected by a committee of experienced tax professionals as the best writing published by the Foundation in 2007. The award, which is conferred annually, is named for the Foundation's late director emeritus.
